8. Cornel PAUNESCU, Vlad PAUNESCU, Mihaela CAMPEANU, Florin NACHE: *Methods for defining errors in the systematic cadaster*

This paper presents a point of view on systematic cadaster errors. In the technical specifications, error (errors) and mistake (mistakes) appear quite frequently and refer to the information that the provider uploads to the database. The Cadaster and Land Book Registry verify these data and compare them with the documents they come from. There is nowhere in the technical specifications or legislation any definition of error or mistake. The proposal is to separate material errors from coarsely errors, which may pose problems for the owners. This would shorten the verification period and fluidization the systematic registration process, since the purpose of the National Program isto accurately tabulated in short time as many immovable.
